### SPEAKING COURSE

<b>Week 1</b>	Restaurant: Making a reservation; understanding the menu; ordering; asking questions about the food; asking for the bill; offering to pay for someone's meal.
<b>Week 2</b>	Hospital: Departments in the hospital (cardiology, radiology, etc.); making an appointment; explaining the issue/problem to the doctor; asking the doctor questions; collecting medicine from the pharmacy.
<b>Week 3</b>	Airport: Ticket purchases; baggage claim; dialogues with plane staff; delay announcements; warnings; passport control.
<b>Week 4</b>	Important phrases and celebrations: What to say to someone who has lost a loved one; how to congratulate your friend on a new job; how a birthday is celebrated; how to send good wishes; how to say you are sorry; how to send wishes on holiday celebrations; which national and religious holidays are celebrated in Turkey.
<b>Week 5</b>	Journey: Asking for directions; giving directions; dialogues that can take place in a minibus, taxi or bus.
<b>Week 6</b>	Cooking: Learn vocabulary used in recipes, including measurement units and kitchen tools and utensils; asking questions about dishes and how to prepare them.
<b>Week 7</b>	Bank: Dialogues that can take place in the bank; account opening; bank related terms; saving money; investing; discussions about the importance of money.
<b>Week 8</b>	Shopping: Dialogues that can take place in the supermarket, market and store; asking for prices; bargaining; making payments for clothes, white goods and food.
<b>Week 9</b>	Travel and hotel: Dialogues that can take place in a hotel; checking in/out; making a request; making a reservation; describing one of your travels.
<b>Week 10</b>	Revision: Creating different dialogues about topics covered in the curriculum.
