

B2 Standard Course

Week 1	Daily life conversations: Meeting new neighbours, conversations between family members or colleagues in the work place. Some short videos will be watched in relation to this. We will practise compound verbs such as <i>yapadur-</i> , <i>bakakal-</i> , <i>yapiver-</i> , <i>gitmeyiver-</i> , etc.
Week 2	Traditions: Turkish traditions related to daily life, special days, bayram, weddings will be talked about. Different functions of –sA suffix will be introduced.
Week 3	News: The news language and its key features will be analysed after reading and listening to some news. Passive forms and the use of -mA, -dlk, -An suffixes will be discussed.
Week 4	Life in Turkey: Health system/services, making appointments, health insurance, etc. A text about health will be analysed. The functions of –Dlk suffix will be highlighted and -diğİnda, -diğİndan, -diğİndan dolayı, -dlkÇA suffixes will be introduced.
Week 5	Scientific writing: Scientific texts will be analysed and differences compared to other types of texts will also be discussed. Some part of the text will be sent before the class.
Week 6	Characters: Personality traits will be talked about. We will watch a video before the class about character analysis. -An suffix will be highlighted.
Week 7	Literature: A part of a story (of which the voice recording will be sent before the class) will be analysed. Compound tense suffixes such as -yordu, -miştİ, acaktİ, -lrdİ, -ecekmiştİ, -yormuş, -miştİmiştİ, etc. will be introduced.
Week 8	Literature: A part of a novel (of which the voice recording will be sent before the class) will be analysed. Reported speech will be introduced. Idioms and some structures will be highlighted in the text.
Week 9	Fashion and clothing: The most famous fashion designers, names of fabrics and designs, words to do with clothing, necessary vocabulary used at a tailor will be covered.
Week 10	Turkish traditional arts: A text will be read and a video recording / videos about Turkish traditional arts will be watched. Some structures such as <i>boyunca</i> , <i>süresince</i> , -Diğİ sürece, -Diğİ zaman, -DlkÇA, -IncA, -Ar -mAz will be analysed.
Week 11	Natural events and types of precipitation: Videos will be watched and related topics discussed. The following structures will be introduced: -mAk yerine, -mAktAnsA, -AcAğİnA, -mAsl halinde, AcAğİl yerde, -Diğİ takdirde, -mAsl durumunda.
Week 12	Life in Turkey: Education system. We will read an article which explains the education system in Turkey and start a discussion about the differences between different countries' systems. The suffixes which have been learnt previously will be practised.
Week 13	Tourism: We will talk about holidays, accommodation and places to visit. We will read an article about the most interesting accommodations / hotels in the world. Reciprocal and causative verbs will be practised: <i>göl</i> , <i>gölüş</i> , <i>göldür</i> , <i>göldürt</i> ; <i>bul-</i> , <i>buluş</i> , <i>buldur</i> , etc.
Week 14	Classical Turkish music: We will learn about classic Turkish instruments and important musicians by reading some articles. Some videos will be sent before the lesson to discuss the topic further. Compound verbs made from auxiliary verbs such as <i>sabretmek</i> , <i>namaz kılmak</i> , <i>seyreylemek</i> , etc. will be practised.
Week 15	Revision and orthography rules: In addition to orthography rules common spelling mistakes will be discussed.
